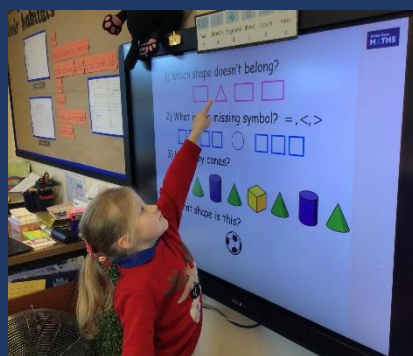
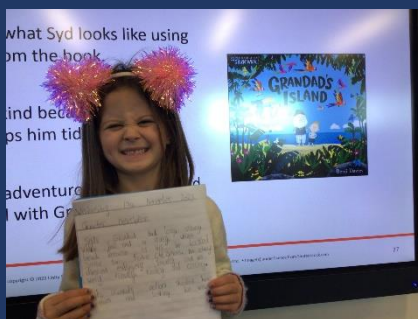
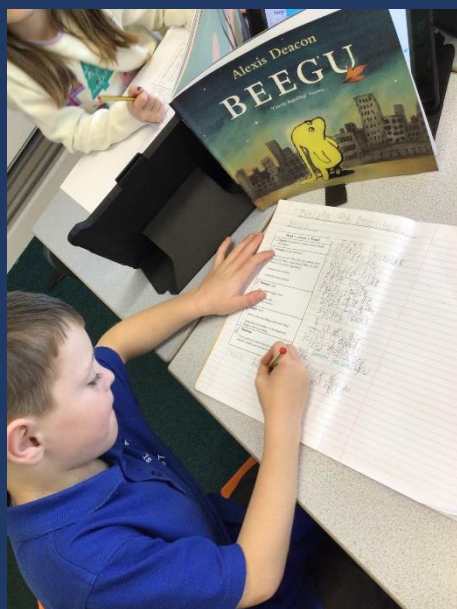
Learning in Action

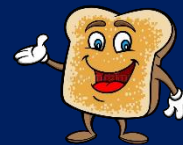


Toast Payment (Jan - Apr 2024)
