
## Learning in Action

#### Year 3

In maths, Year 3 have been learning about the place value of numbers up to 1000. In English, the children have been focusing on subordinating clauses and expanded noun phrases to create super sentences within their work. During their reading lessons, Year 3 have continued their story of the Viking adventure and tales of Beowulf.
